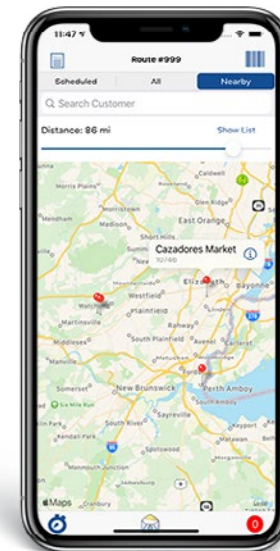

RJ-4250WB Rugged mobile printer offers a long battery life that is sufficient to run an entire day operation or longer without charging. With the ability to dock, all our RJ-4250WB Rugged mobile printers are removed from our trucks each night to place on large docking stations in our warehouse to charge overnight, so that they could be ready to use in our next day operation.", said Sam Chen.

Yumi operates 127 routes each day. Their drivers could only generate revenue, only when they are on the road. Hence, route efficiency is very important. "As our drivers usually start their day around 4.30am in our warehouse, we try to reduce their time spent in our warehouse by getting ready everything they require for their delivery.", said Sam Chen.

Their drivers will check to ensure the things they require to run smoothly, including checking their tires, gasoline level, freezer temperature, iOS devices and RJ-4250WB Rugged mobile printers. "Our drivers could pick up their fully charged RJ-4250WB Rugged mobile printers from our docking stations, located in our warehouse, with their iOS devices that are numbered, so that they could grab their right sets to go. Our drivers will usually spend around 10 - 12 hours a day or sometimes even longer during busy season. Each driver has to be 'route ready' with their correct inventory and connected devices to ensure no time is wasted in incurring any unnecessary trip back

to their warehouse. As their drivers will stop at each customers' location, they will check to ensure that their customers will accept their delivery at that specific time, before pulling out their inventory ordered to load along with Brother's RJ-4250WB Rugged mobile printers and phones to commence their delivery, which has helped to achieve operations efficiency.

Customers will do a quick inventory check to ensure that their delivered items match with what they have ordered with no discrepancies. Their drivers will also arrange their goods in-store in a presentable way and ensure their stores' inventory are always fresh and not expired. After that, they will check out with their customer by printing out a receipt to request for payment or to obtain a signature for their good delivery. Their receipts are often 1 foot long or sometimes up to 3 to 4 feet long for large orders. Brother's RJ-4250WB Rugged mobile printers could print them out easily.", continued Sam Chen.
